What are ENQA Agency Reviews?

ENQA offers external reviews of quality assurance agencies to assess their compliance with the **Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the EHEA (ESG)**. An external review against the ESG is a prerequisite to become a member of ENQA and to apply for listing on EQAR.

ENQA's new targeted reviews, established in collaboration with EQAR, further strengthen the enhancement aspect of the review, while offering a more resource-minded evaluation process for agencies that have already undergone two full reviews.



As a part of the ENQA Agency Reviews process, agencies are offered the opportunity to take part in a progress visit – a unique enhancement-oriented exercise that focuses on key challenges or topics as chosen by the agency.
