ENQA Leadership Programme Seminar 2 Bucharest, 11 – 13 December 2019

Venue:

The second seminar of the ENQA Leadership Development Programme 2019 is hosted by the Romanian Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (ARACIS) and will take place at the ARACIS headquarters located at the University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Bucharest - USAMV Bucharest, Faculty of Land Reclamation and Environmental Engineering), Mărăști Boulevard 59 (Ground floor), postal code 011464, district 1, Bucharest, Romania.

Arrival and transport

Participants are kindly requested to make their own international and local travel arrangements.

Getting to Bucharest

The Bucharest Henri Coandă International Airport is located about 12 kilometers away from the event venue.

- Public transportation (STB): Bus express lines 780 or 783 from Henri Coandă Airport to the station Piața Presei (the trip takes about 35 minutes). Price for one card with two trips is about 7 lei (less than 2 Euros); card desk is in front of the Arrivals Terminal. The ticket must be validated inside the bus.

- Taxis are available with fares between 1.39 lei/km and 3.5 lei/km; the cars are situated in a taxi station located at the exit of the Arrivals Terminal. The trip takes about 15 minutes. Please use the "Taxi by request" desk within the airport. The fare should be maximum 10 Euros from the Airport to the Pullman Hotel or the workshop venue, equivalent of about 50 lei; please ask the driver for receipt. Exchange booth at the airport.

Moving around the city

Bucharest has a thorough public transportation system with buses and metro lines.

Bus lines (STB)

Before getting on a STB vehicle, passengers must make sure they have a proper ticket for the respective public transport vehicle and with the proper fare for the respective period. The tickets can be purchased from the STB centers for issuing and recharging cards.

The Activ card, loaded with the electronic wallet as well as the Multiplu card loaded with a number of journeys, will be validated at the existing special appliances, immediately after getting into the vehicle.

For the non-nominal ACTIV card, the minimum value for the electronic wallet is 2,6 lei; The value of one STB journey is: 1,3 lei for urban routes.

Metro lines (Metrorex)

The passengers' access to platforms is permitted only after tickets are purchased and validated by the fare collection system. The tickets can be purchased from the ticket points of sales in all stations. Price valid for two trips (which is the minimum option) is 5 lei.

Participants are kindly requested to make their own accommodation arrangements.

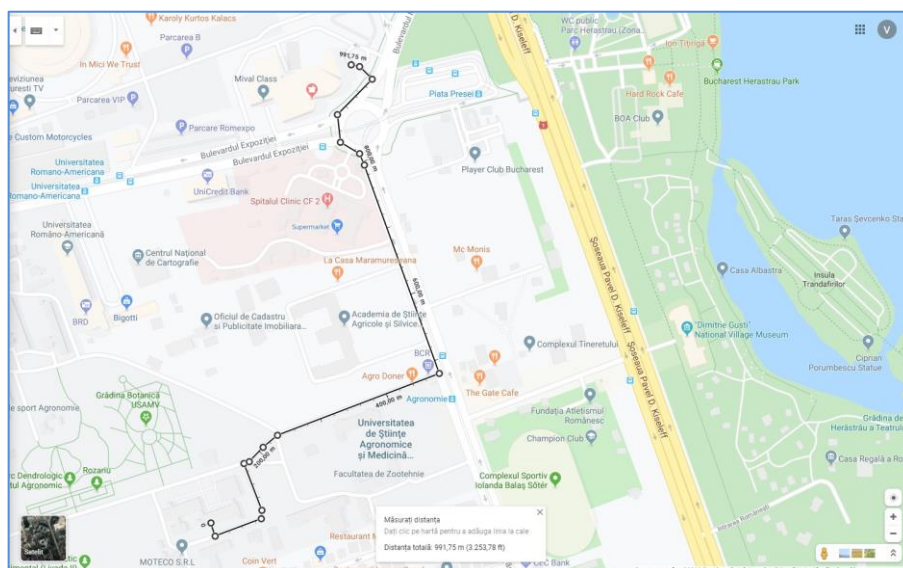
Accommodation have been reserved for the participants at a 4-star hotel close to the venue (600m):

The room rate is 75 EUR/night, single room, breakfast included and the city tax (about 1%) is not included in this rate.
