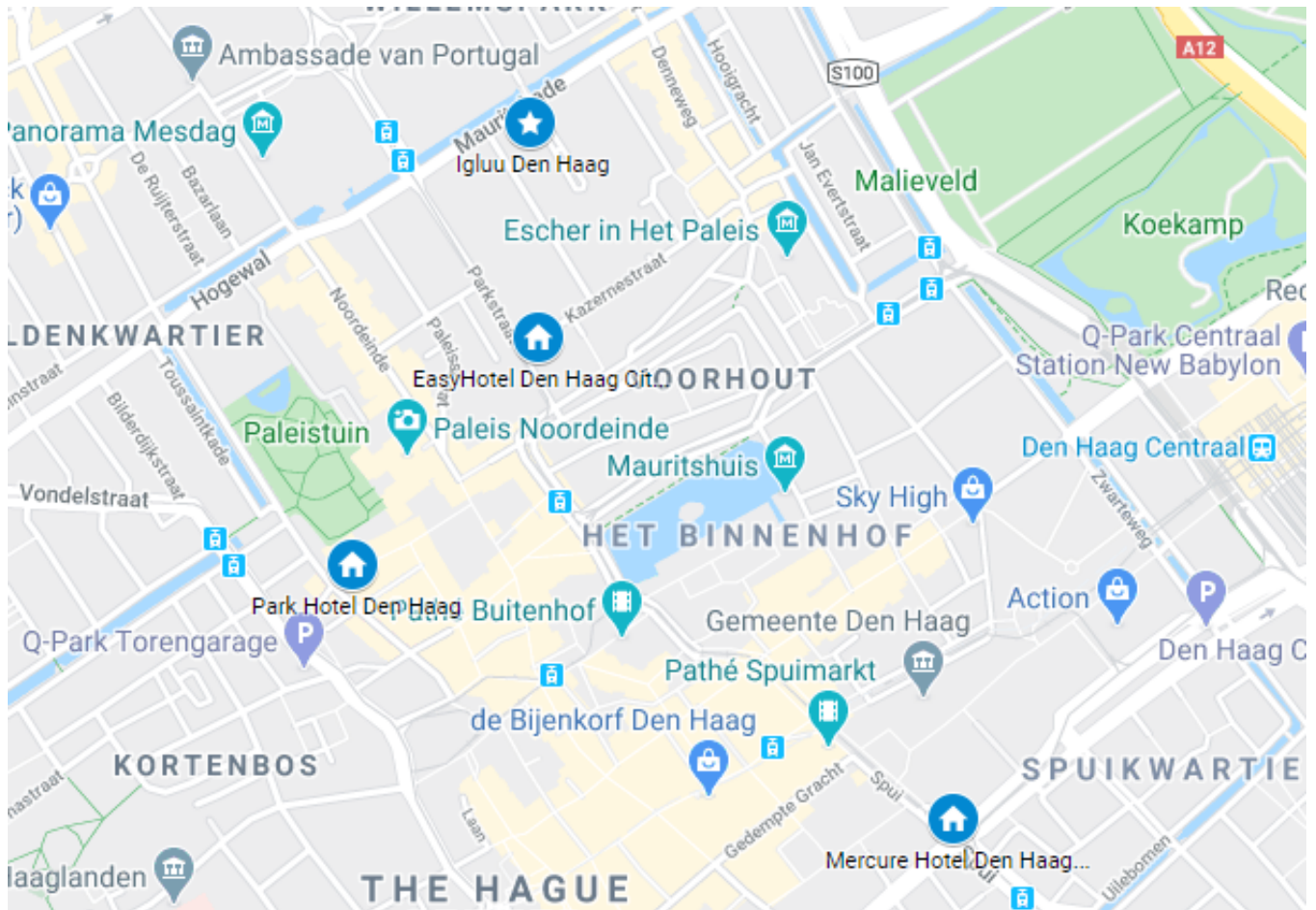


**PRACTICAL INFORMATION**
