

## 2023 ENQA MEMBERS' FORUM

### Call for Contributions

**ENQA is pleased to invite members and affiliates to submit contributions for presentation at the 2023 Members' Forum, taking place on 20-21 April in Tbilisi, Georgia. Contributions are sought on the topic of 'Enhancement-led external QA: beyond the ESG'.**

As internal and external QA systems become more mature, many QA agencies are seeking ways to ensure the continued relevance and added value of their work. This may include revising their regular QA processes to ensure added value after multiple cycles of external QA or broadening the services on offer to provide guidance, analysis or reviews on specific themes that go beyond the standard criteria used for accountability.

#### Theme of the contributions

In order to share practice and discuss developments, contributions are being sought that present a case example of:

- How your agency ensures external QA processes have an added value for institutions/programmes that have been through multiple review processes
- Additional services provided to institutions or other stakeholders (e.g. guidance, training, analysis, peer learning) on topics that go beyond compliance with baseline standards
- Other relevant activities that support institutions or the broader HE sector in improving the quality of education provision, but which go beyond the regular cyclical external QA processes.

Two types of contributions are sought:

- Posters: an A1-size printed poster, with a clear visually attractive presentation of your case example
- Powerpoint slides: 2-3 Powerpoint slides with a clear and visually attractive presentation of your case example

If your contribution is selected, you will be invited to present it during one of two thematic sessions at the Members' Forum. During the session, you will have 5 minutes to present your case example, followed by 10 minutes for questions and discussion with participants. You will present your case example 4 times during the session, while participants rotate around the presentations in small groups.

The sessions are an excellent opportunity for you to showcase the work of your agency, while facilitating peer learning and discussion among participants. Therefore the contributions should explain an innovative, practical method or practice that can provide inspiration for agencies facing similar challenges.

The audience at the Members' Forum is primarily leadership and staff from QA agencies across the European Higher Education Area.

## Submission process

Submissions for this call for contributions should take the form of a c.1-page application, including the following information:

- Presenter and agency
- Title and theme
- Abstract of maximum 200 words
- 2-3 discussion questions based on the case example
- Format of presentation: poster or Powerpoint slides

Attention should be paid to the formulation of the title and abstract as these will be provided to participants to allow them to decide which presentations to attend.

The deadline for submissions is **27 February**.

The results of the selection process will be announced by **6 March**.

Please note that contributions are expected to be presented in person during the event and that travel/accommodation costs for participation should be covered by the presenter/agency.
