

2025 ENQA MEMBERS' FORUM

Call for Contributions

ENQA is pleased to invite members and affiliates to submit contributions for presentation at the [2025 Members' Forum](#), taking place on 9-11 April in Paphos, Cyprus. Contributions are sought on the topic of 'Sustainability in Quality Assurance'.

Quality assurance agencies promote many dimensions of sustainability both through their own practices and by supporting the broader sustainability goals of higher education institutions. They support institutions in integrating environmental, social, and economic sustainability into education, research, and community engagement. At the same time, agencies ensure their own sustainability by adopting practices that align with these principles, while seeking to maintain sustainability of financial and human resources.

Themes of the contributions

In order to share practice and discuss developments, contributions are being sought that address different dimensions of sustainability in QA, these might include (but are not limited to):

- Sustainable QA procedures: How do quality assurance agencies ensure the sustainability of their procedures, standards and criteria by involving stakeholders such as students, academics, and industry representatives in their development and revision?
- Sustainability in higher education: how do agencies cover different dimensions of sustainability in their external QA activities (e.g. standards and criteria) or through thematic work with institutions?
- Sustainable resources: how do agencies ensure their long-term operation through stable financial and human resources? Or how do they improve efficiency through the use of digital tools?
- Environmental sustainability: what policies and practices do agencies have in place to reduce their environmental impact?

Contributing with an example at the Members' Forum is an excellent opportunity to showcase the work of your agency, while facilitating peer learning and discussion among participants. Contributions should explain a concrete policy or practice that can provide inspiration for agencies addressing similar issues.

Format of the contributions

Contributions should be in the form of an A1-size printed poster, with a clear visually attractive presentation of the case example.

If your contribution is selected, you will be invited to present it during one of the thematic poster sessions at the Members' Forum. During the session, you will have 5 minutes to present your case example, followed by 10 minutes for questions and discussion with participants. You will present your case example several times during the session, while participants rotate around the presentations in small groups.

The audience at the Members' Forum is primarily leadership and staff from QA agencies across the European Higher Education Area.

Submission process

Submissions for this call for contributions should take the form of a completed application form (available [here](#)), including the following information:

- Presenter(s) and agency
- Title and theme
- Abstract of maximum 200 words
- 2-3 discussion questions based on the case example

Attention should be paid to a concise and informative formulation of the title and abstract as these will be provided to participants to allow them to decide which presentations to attend.

Submissions should be sent by email to secretariat@enqa.eu.

The deadline for submissions is **24 February**.

The results of the selection process will be announced by **10 March**.

Please note that contributions are expected to be presented in person during the event and that travel/accommodation costs for participation should be covered by the presenter/agency. Presenters will be asked to provide a pdf file of their poster in advance of the event, and this will be published on the ENQA website afterwards.
