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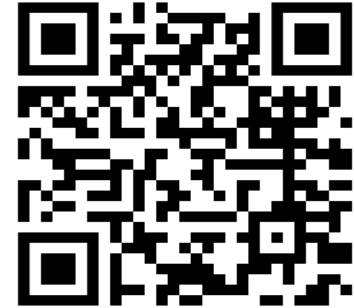

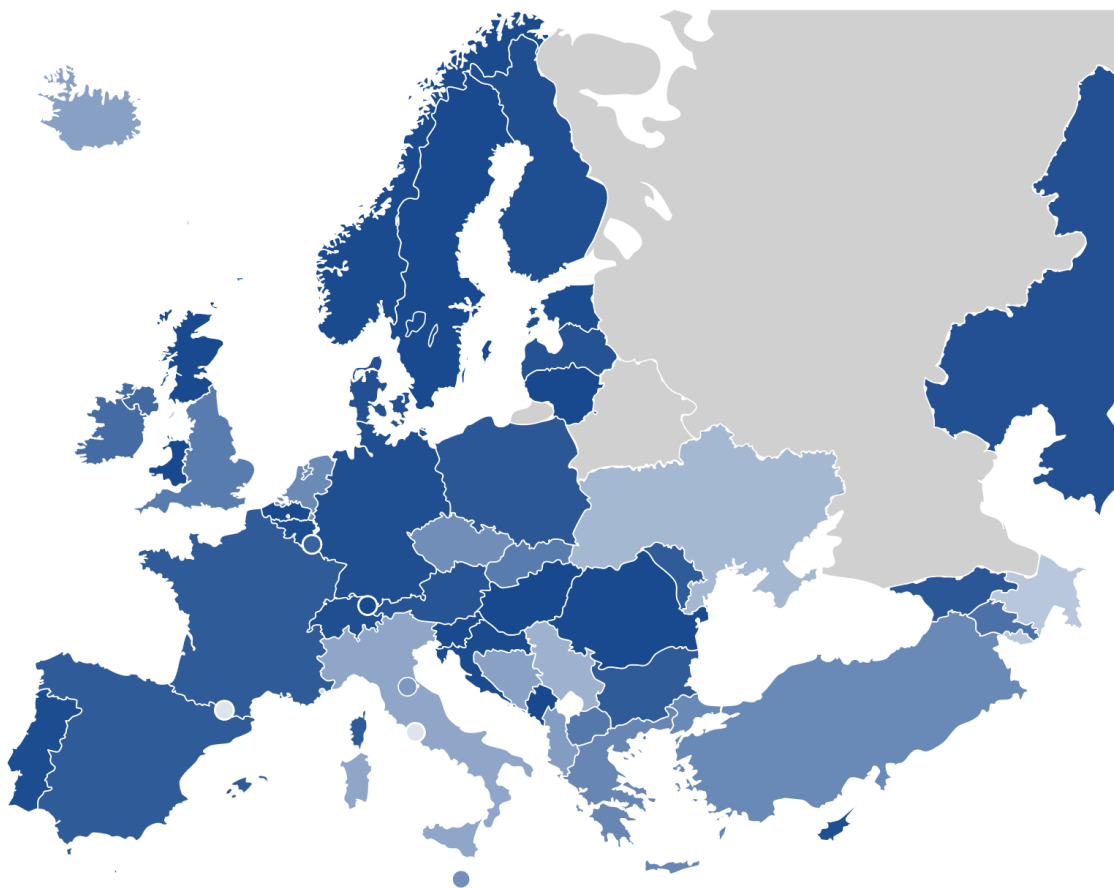

- Easy access to external quality assurance (QA) reports (i.e. **accreditations and evaluations**) and decisions by EQAR-registered agencies (**ONLY higher education**)

Expansion of information in DEQAR

1. Accreditations and evaluations of (provider level):

a) **Full degree programmes** → **Full (nationally) recognised degree**

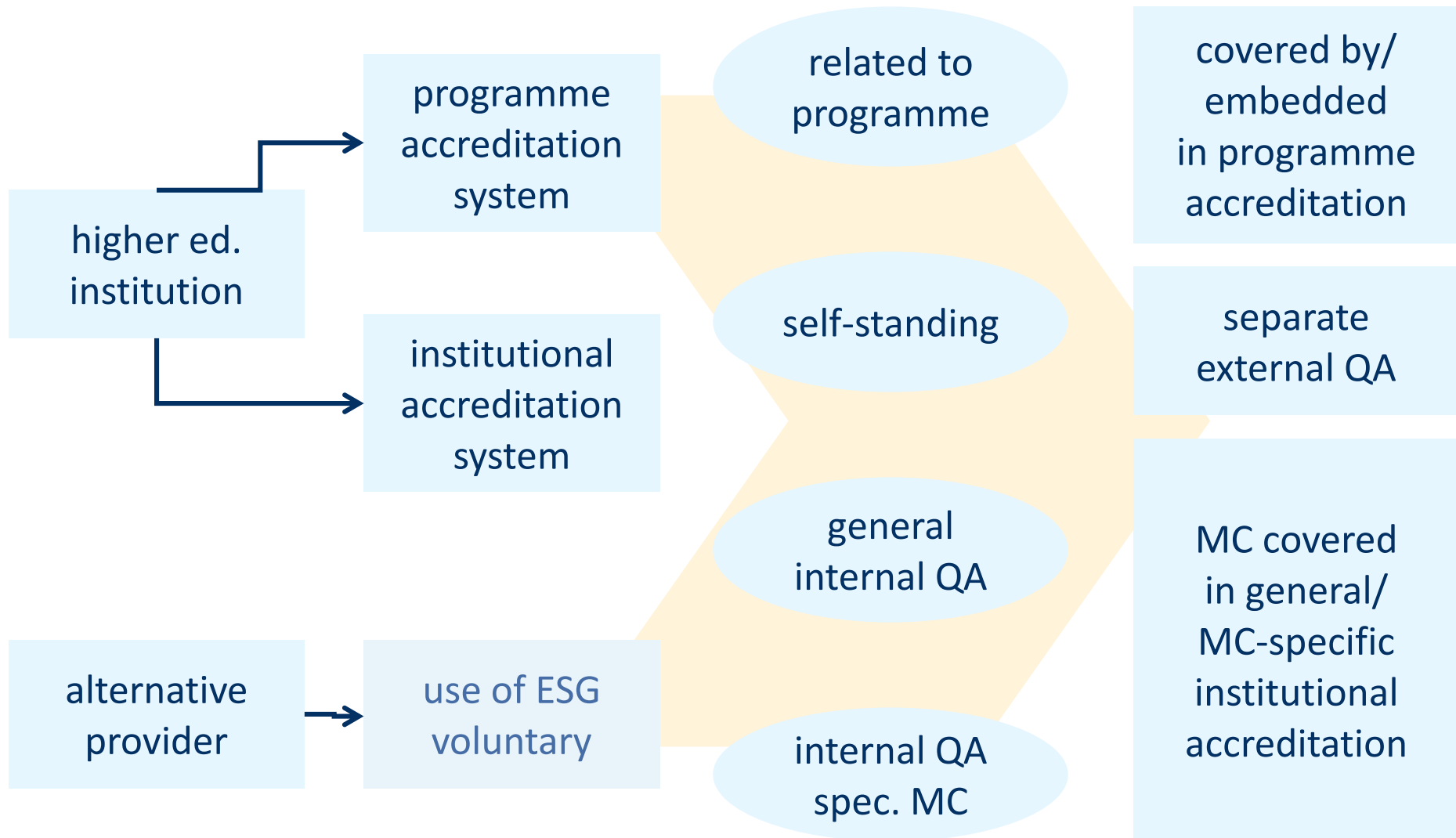

Definition of a micro-credential

A study provision:

- a) Consisted by a **workload expressed in ECTS** in the range of **1 and 59 ECTS credits**
- b) Related to **EQF/ISCED level (5), 6, 7 or 8** OR **QF EHEA level short, first, second, third cycle**
- c) Does **not** lead to a **full (recognised) degree**

Scenarios in practice



Main observations process

1. The micro-credentials usually bore up to **30 ECTS**.

Main observations

2. Most of the **other providers** were established as **non governmental organisations**, some as private companies. Rarely public organisations or public-private partnerships
3. **Micro-credentials** can be **tied to a QF level** (reference – entry qualification)
4. The **use of terminology** “diploma”, “bachelor”, “master” **is not always protected via national legislation** (hence providers can utilise it for own purposes)

Feasibility Study on Quality Label – Sep. 2024

Feasibility assessment on the establishment of an ESG-based quality label for all providers that operate in alignment with the European Approach for Micro-credentials, in dialogue with alternative providers.

- *What are the perceptions of educational providers and QA agencies on the necessity of implementing a quality label for micro - credentials?*
- *What is the added value of a quality label for micro-credentials?*

Quality labels by EQAR-registered agencies – Major observations

- Over 30 quality labels by 30 EQAR-registered agencies.
- Most of the labels use common peer-review principles and are given after (as a result) of an external review. However, some of the labels are only awarded if the educational provider has demonstrated excellence.
- Quality labels are mostly awarded by the implementing agency, but in some cases, they can also be awarded through authorised agencies (Euro-inf Quality Label, EUR-ACE, Eurolabel Chemistry Quality Label, CEQUINT).

Feasibility Study on Quality Label - Stakeholder Perceptions

Stakeholder perceptions are assessed to gauge the perceived need for a quality assurance label, and gather insights on potential benefits or concerns.

- Desk research using data stored at agencies' websites
- IMINQA Working group on QA of Micro-Credentials
- ***ENQA's Member Forum (now)***
- Focus group with alternative providers

1) What is the **added value for creating a quality label** demonstrating that the micro-credential has been evaluated/accredited (using methodology aligned with the ESGs)?

- **Scenario 1:** Considering the workload, would you award a label based on the evaluation of each micro-credential or at the level of micro-credential provider?
- **Scenario 2:** Should such label be issued by QA agency or another body/ies (e.g. national or regional (professional) body, international entity or someone else)?

3) For the national agencies, are there any **regulations for issuing and using labels applicable to micro-credentials** provided by HEIs or alternative providers in your system?

4) Based on your experience, would HEIs and **alternative providers** in your context be **interested in undergoing a review with QA agency** and obtain a label for the micro-credentials they provide?
