

2022 ENQA MEMBERS' FORUM – Call for Proposals

The team behind the organisation of the programme for the 2022 ENQA Members' Forum (Cardiff, Wales, 22-24 June) invites all ENQA members and affiliates to consider submitting a proposal to present a poster during one of two poster sessions.

The poster sessions provide an opportunity for organisations to present their unique experience, seek advice on an unresolved challenge or to advise on the successful implementation or use of a specific quality assurance tool or practice. They also provide an opportunity for peer learning and discussion among participants. While the themes are rather generic, the posters should clearly showcase an innovative, practical method or practice or a particular experience that can help other agencies that face similar challenges or are eager to take advantage of similar opportunities.

Given the very condensed nature of these presentations and that participants will freely choose which poster presentation to attend, it is vital that presenters consider how to attract an interested audience (that is mindful already of the topic to be discussed) with a skilfully chosen title for their poster session and a strict, 200-word abstract which shall be provided to participants in advance. The audience will consist mainly of quality assurance practitioners.

Example of the timeline:

16.45-17.00 Participants attend first poster of their choice

17.05-17.20 Participants attend second poster of their choice

17.25-17.40 Participants attend third poster of their choice

17.45-18.00 Participants attend fourth poster of their choice

The proposals should fall within one (or more) of the following themes:

Session for affiliates (Thursday 23rd June afternoon):

- Journey towards ESG compliance
- Added value of international cooperation in the field of quality of higher education

Session for members and affiliate (Friday 24th June morning):

- New ideas and developments in quality and quality assurance of higher education (such as innovative methods, instruments, dialogue with stakeholders, meeting new trends in HE, etc)

Poster session proposals (of approximately one page in length) should be sent to the ENQA Secretariat (secretariat@enqa.eu) by **6 May** and should:

- Identify the presenter and the agency
- Include the draft title and identify which theme it suits
- Include the draft abstract (strictly limited to 200 words)
- Explain the main objectives/intended learning outcomes considering the target audience

Attention should be paid to the formulation of the title suitable to attract interested audience.

Agencies are free to submit more than one proposal. Accepted proposals will be notified by **18 May**.

Presenting during the poster session is voluntary and associated costs are borne by the presenter/agency. Kindly note that posters are anticipated to be A1-size, portrait orientation.

Presenters will be invited to record a short video of their poster presentation to be posted on ENQA website if they wish to further disseminate it.
