

Trends and innovations: what's new in the ENQA family? Call for contributions

ENQA is seeking contributions from members and affiliates for a webinar that will share recent trends and innovations taking place in quality assurance agencies or systems.

Sharing of developments and transferable lessons between agencies across the EHEA and beyond is an important peer-learning mechanism to inspire and support continuous improvement. In order to facilitate this, ENQA will organise a webinar to highlight examples from members and affiliates that demonstrate new activities or significant changes in quality assurance approaches that are of interest to the whole ENQA community.

This is an excellent opportunity for ENQA members and affiliates to showcase new aspects of their work and share the lessons learnt that are relevant beyond the original context.

ENQA is calling for case examples from members and affiliates to be presented during the webinar. Contributions should focus on a significant change in approaches to external quality assurance or innovations in specific areas of activity.

Topics of particular interest include:

- Significant changes in approaches or frameworks for external quality assurance in your agency or system
- Results of recent analysis or recent of quality assurance or higher education (e.g. recent thematic analysis)
- Recent innovations in activities of your agency (e.g. related to stakeholder engagement, collaboration with other agencies/organisations, international activities, new services for the higher education sector)

Presentations should include key lessons learnt from the new activities and reflect on how these lessons are relevant and transferable to other agencies.

Presentations on developments related solely to the Covid-19 pandemic will not be selected as ENQA has held other webinars on this topic earlier in the year (see here: [Part 1](#) and [Part 2](#)).

Around six contributions will be selected for presentation during the webinar, with each presenter given a slot of 5-7 minutes. Time will also be allocated for questions and discussion with the audience.

The webinar will take place on Friday 22 October 2021, 10.00-11.30 CEST. It will form part of the ENQA online General Assembly seminar and replaces the poster sessions that were a popular part of the physical event format. The webinar is open exclusively to members and affiliates.

Submission process

Submissions to this call should consist of:

- Maximum 2-3 slides to be used during the webinar, for a presentation of 5-7 minutes
- Written summary of the main points of the presentation (maximum 250 words)
- Completed submission form ([download here](#))

The deadline for submissions is Monday 11 October 2021.

The call is open only to ENQA members and affiliates.

The selection of contributions will be made by the ENQA secretariat. Presenters will be informed by Wednesday 13 October. The webinar will take place on Friday 22 October at 10.00-11.30 CEST.
