**Subject: NCPA follow-up report to the 2019 ENQA review**

At its meeting on 13 and 14 September 2021, the Board of ENQA considered the follow-up report arising from the external review of the National Centre of Public Accreditation (NCPA) in 2019.

The Board approves the report and takes note of the progress that has been made. At the same time, the Board urges the agency to define a clearer timeline and assigns responsibilities when addressing the remaining recommendations (i.e., in relation to ESG 3.1, ESG 3.6, ESG 2.5 and ESG 2.7). Regarding the standard 2.4, the Board asks the agency to carefully consider requirements of the ESG, where student members are considered as equal members of external quality assurance panels, and not solely as 'listeners'.
