



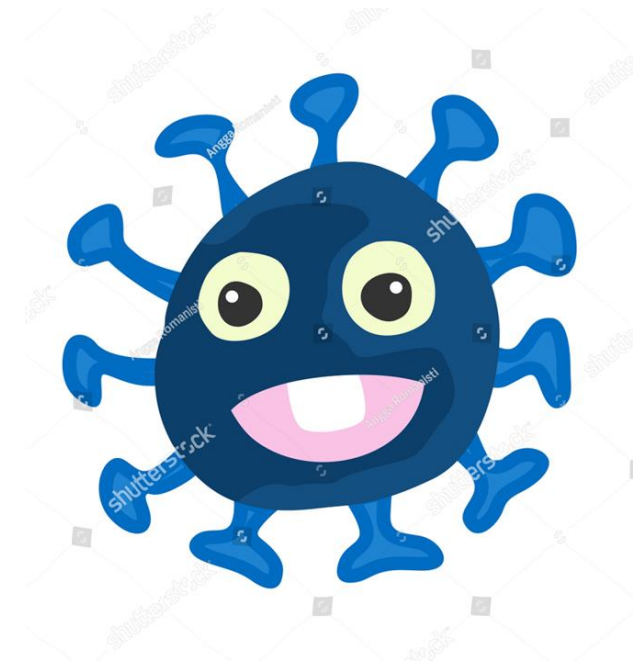

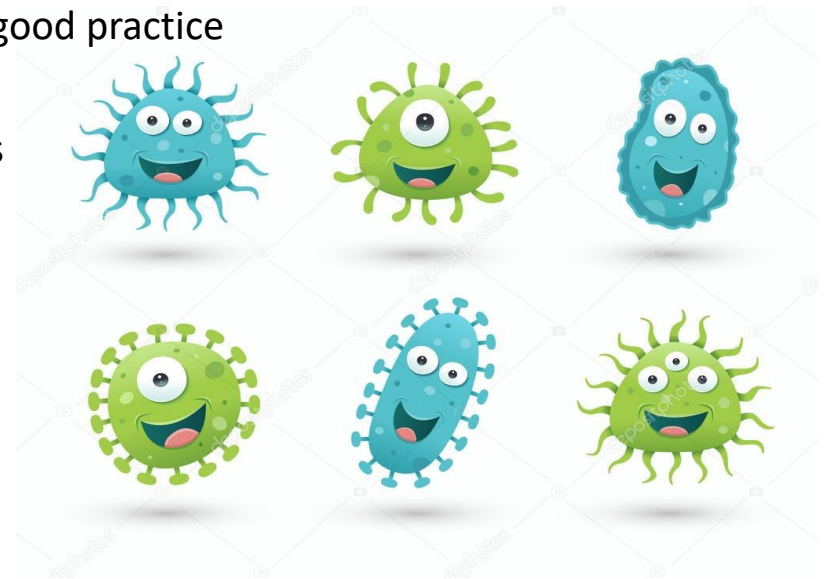


The report is both the end product and the focus of the review process

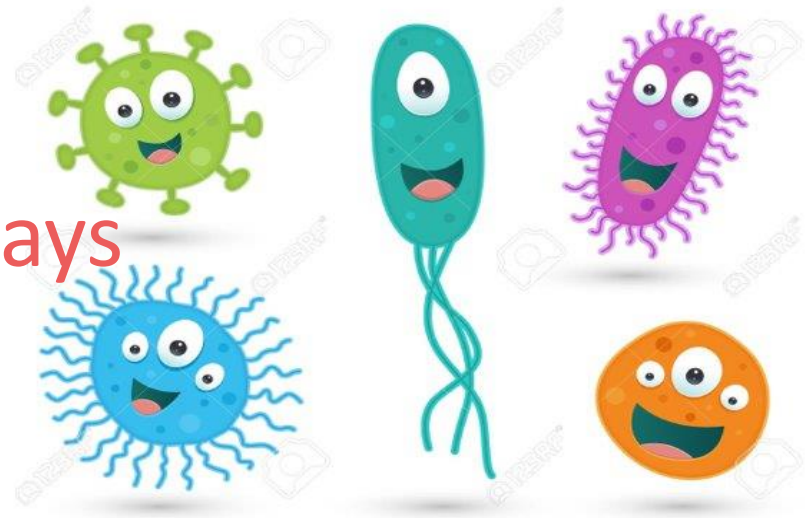
