



Next generation of institutional reviews



More comprehensive supervision + knowledge sharing

Information meetings, grouping of institutions, seminars

Flexible degree of site-visit

First phase ("control")

Minimum set of requirements for every HEIs (self-reporting)
More in-depth review if needed

Corrective measures

Clear distinction between first and second phase

Expert panel 4 (1)

Bench-learning activity

Second phase ("follow-up")

Choice of enhancement areas (self-evaluation)

Voluntary measures
