FOLLOW-UP ON TARGETED REVIEWS

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AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- A follow-up is an **integral part** of the targeted review process.
- Since the targeted review already focuses on reviewing the remaining challenges of the agency's ESG compliance, the targeted review follow-up focuses on supporting the agency in its continuous **reflection and enhancement**.

ONLINE FOLLOW-UP SEMINAR

- All agencies that undergo a targeted review are expected to attend the seminar (e.g., agencies' resource person, lead author of the SAR, or leadership representative(s)).
- Aims to provide an arena for strategic conversations that allow the agencies to reflect on their **key challenges, opportunities, and priorities**.
- Agencies' **self-selected enhancement standards and changes** in their contexts will guide the design of the seminar
 - To prepare for the follow-up seminar, the participants will be asked to demonstrate changes or developments within their agency following the targeted review
- To be organised every 2 years
- Online to ensure participation (low cost)
